Guides and Outfitting for Your Next Adventure!

DH1 - Seneca Trail Day Hike - Experience this 4 mile hike in the Sugar Hill area. It's a beautiful hike that relaxes you and looses your anxieties. When you are at the trail's end you'll wish for more. **4 mi / 3 hrs**

DH2 - Finger Lakes Trail - Sugar Hill to Watkins Glen - Beautiful waterfalls, wild lakes and scenery. The trail can be broken up into 3-mile segments to accommodate a mixture of hiking abilities. If a member of your party wishes to only hike one portion of the trail, accommodations are made for them at the desired trail segment. At the end of the trail, your party can experience dinner at the Seneca Lodge where the food is of excellent choice (Dinner is not included in the hiking package price). **9 mi / 6 hrs**

DH3 - Erwin Wildlife Management at Daybreak - The air literally explodes with the sounds of birds singing. An incredible and very enjoyable experience. A continental breakfast is served at the pond area. **2 mi / 2 hrs**

DH4 - Finger Lakes National Forest - A beautiful area with creeks and ponds. An abundance of wildlife and nature brings the trail to life. The north end of the trail is approx 4 miles long and the south end of the trail is approx 6 miles long. If a member of your party wishes to only hike at the upper portion or the lower portion of the trail, accommodations for them are made for them while they wait. A cookout can also be added for an additional fee. **10 mi / 8 hrs**

One Day Adventures

DH5 - Mohawk Trail - Spur Trail off the Finger Lakes Trail. The trail is a wonderful trail for beginners and experienced hikers. Hills with streams and reforested lands by conservationist. The whispering pines and babbling brooks keeps your mind at ease on this trail while you think of the Native Americans which once occupied this area. **4 mi / 3 hrs**

DH6 - Cayuga/Seneca Trail- At the end of the Seneca Trail have a cookout and afterwards, work it off with a short two mile walk. The Cayuga is a very gentle walk of two miles while the Seneca is 4 miles. A total of 6 miles of great relaxation. **6 mi / 8 hrs**

DH7 - Oneida Trail- Not a trail for the faint hearted in some parts of the trail, but never less beautiful. Our guides make sure that everyone gets through this truly beautiful wooded area along the Finger Lakes Trail. **4 mi / 3 hrs**

NY State guides are defined as the following by the NY DEC:

"The licensing of outdoor guides is regulated by the New York State Forest Rangers. In general terms, a guide is a person, at least eighteen years of age, who offers services for hire part or all of which includes directing, instructing or aiding another in fishing, hunting, camping, hiking, whitewater rafting and canoeing, or rock and ice climbing. Individuals engaging in the business of guiding on all lands and waters of the state shall possess a license issued by the department."
